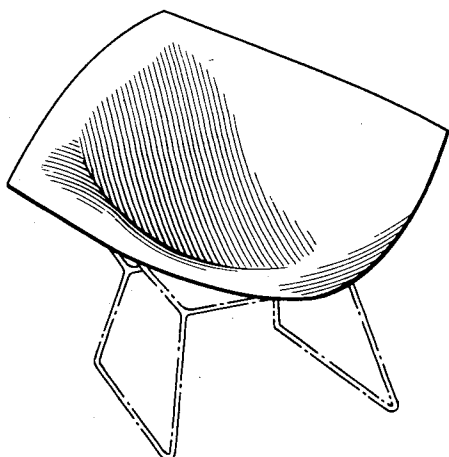

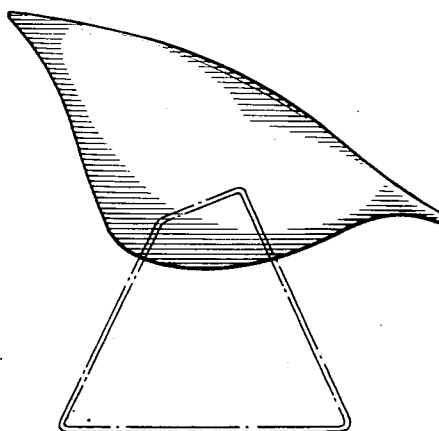

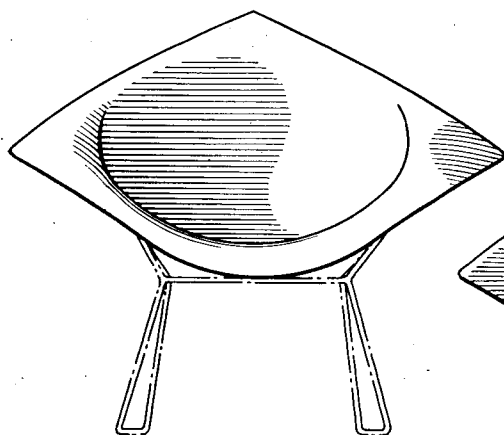
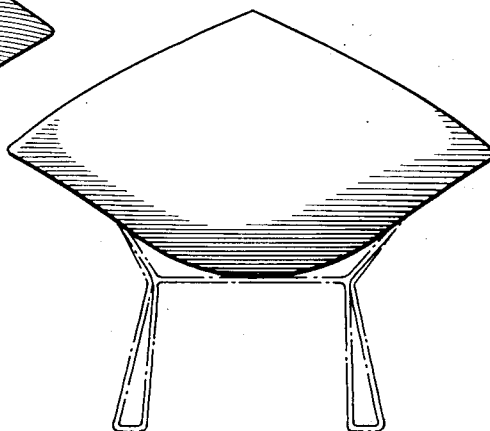

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Harry Bertoia, a citizen of the United States of America, and residing at Pennsburg, county of Montgomery, Pa., have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Chair, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof:

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a chair, showing my new design,

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof,

Fig. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, and
